of all that is, seen and unseen.

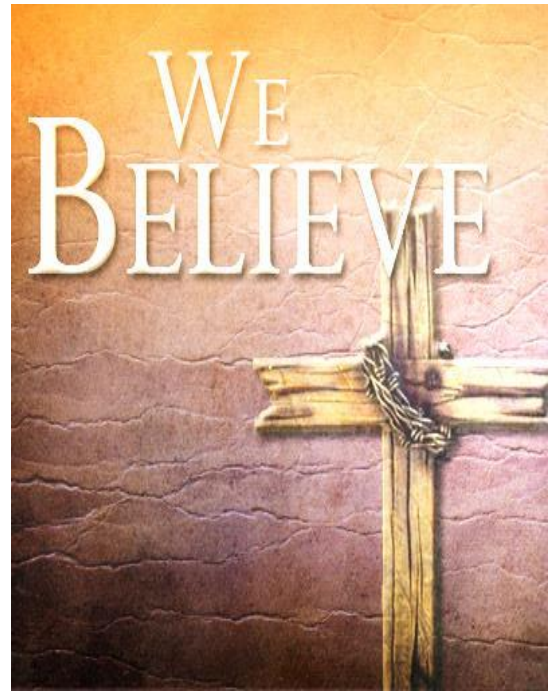
We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ,
